## For your Outdoor Pienics and Barbecues



When you go shopping for all your outdoor eating needs think of which non-recyclable items you can avoid using and instead use reusable-plastic or paper plates vs. styrofoam plates, reusable metal utensils vs. plastic utensils, cloth table covers vs. plastic covers, paper cups vs. styrofoam cups... what else can you think of? At checkout you may want to request paper bags for later use as a food scrap and food soiled paper disposal bag.

## Recycling Made Easy

Planning ahead for your disposal needs can ensure that as much as possible gets recycled and is diverted from our landfills. Please be sure to separate aluminum cans, plastic, glass bottles and other recyclables and put them in your recycling cart.
Have a paper bag for food scraps, food soiled paper containers, paper plates/cups/napkins. Put your paper bag of food scraps and food soiled paper in the organics cart. Since these materials are for composting please be careful not to contaminate the organics cart with plastic silverware, plastic bags, glass or metal.

## Dispose of Household Hazardous Waste Safely, Conveniently - and Free!

Check your house, garage, and yard for common household products (such as cleaners, paints, car products, and pesticides) that may be hazardous to your children, your pets or the environment.
Words such as danger, warning, caution, poisonous, and flammable on the labels can mean a product is toxic. Label the toxic products you find as a reminder to use them up and dispose of them safely. Do not put these materials in garbage carts or empty into storm drains.

## What Do I Put Into the Organics Cart?

The reason Organics Carts are so important is that they help divert tons of materials away from our landfills which saves costs and is better for the environment. Here is a list to help you utilize your cart efficiently. Thank you for helping us provide you with the best possible service.

Organics Acceptable List

- Grass and weed clippings
- Shrubs and tree prunings (less than 4" in diameter)
- Leaves, plants and flowers
- Food scraps and food soiled paper products

Non-acceptable Organics List

- No household garbage
- No plastic bags
- No dirt or rocks
- No overloading - lid must be closed
